Further to our conversation with the Director after court this morning, we would be grateful if you could make enquiries and obtain any relevant documents in relation to the following. This will assist us in working through whether the briefing documents ultimately provided to the ACT DPP can be said to have been prepared by the relevant ACT Policing members for the dominant purpose of obtaining legal advice.

* 31 March 2021 - records of the meeting with the ACT DPP at Winchester. We are advised that the following members were present:

- Marcus Boorman, Trent Madders, Emma Frizzell, Jason McDevitt and ? Saunders (apologies, I don't have a first name for this member)

* 1 June 2021 - records of the meeting with the DPP at the office of the DPP, at which providing the summaries of evidence and the brief were apparently discussed. We are advised that the following members were present:

- Scott Moller, Marcus Boorman

* 1-17 June 2022 - diary note entries for Scott Moller in relation to the investigation. The Director says he received a call from Scott Moller on 7 June in relation to the test under s 26 of the Magistrates Court Act.

* Inspector Marcus Boorman's account of the purpose for which he created the document dated 4 June 2021

* Detective Sergeant Jason McDevitt's account of the purpose for which he created the attached document "review doc for DPP"

The attached document is an additional document provided to us this afternoon. As per Emma Frizzell's attached email, the collated information in the document titled "Review doc for DPP" was used in Marcus Boorman's briefing document.

Grateful if you could discuss this with Jason, since the title of the file lends some weight to the argument that the briefing documents were prepared for the purpose of seeking advice from the DPP.

At this stage I expect we will check in with you on Monday afternoon to discuss and progress and next steps, but will keep you posted on any change in plans.
