R v Lehrmann – ACT Board of Inquiry – voluntary production of documents – second tranche

1. We refer to the subpoena served on 6 February 2023 and our previous correspondence relating to the manner in which the AFP intends to cooperate in providing the information sought, notwithstanding the Commonwealth's position that it is not subject to the compulsory powers set out in the *Inquiries Act 1991*.

Voluntary production of requested documents

- 2. We **enclose** documents comprising the second tranche of documents from the AFP, relating to the following categories:
 - Category 8 in relation to this category the documents are provided with redactions to certain items over which the AFP asserts legal professional privilege. Limited redactions have also been applied to the contact details of AFP members;
