- * ACTP CI provided a preliminary brief of evidence to ACT DPP on Monday 21 June 2021 for advice regarding proceeding to prosecution.
- * Preliminary advice received on 28 June 2021 is there is a reasonable prospect of conviction and public interest in proceeding.
- * A full brief of evidence was provided for review by an independent team led by Commander Andrew Smith.

- * The review has been finalised and determined that the investigation was of a high standard and was subject to complimentary commentary towards the ACTP investigative team.
